Garnett R. Stowe, Jr. is the Vice President, National Intelligence Programs and Space for the Raytheon Company. He was previously a Principal with the consulting firm Booz Allen Hamilton functioning as a Business Leader in the firm's national Security Business Segment. Prior to his role at Booz Allen Hamilton he served as a senior executive at the Central Intelligence Agency.

In his current position, Mr. Stowe is responsible for business development, strategy, and metrics for the Defense and Intelligence Communities and NASA. Mr. Stowe has overall responsibility for domestic sales and bookings in the Defense and Intelligence Communities and NASA; the National Space and Geo-Spatial Intelligence Business Development Team; the near term business initiatives, including follow-on work, on-contract growth, and new business pursuits.
