

## **Leo Hazlewood**

Leo Hazlewood joined Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) in March 2000 as Corporate Vice President and Director for Intelligence Programs in the Space, Intelligence and Information Sector. Following time on the sector staff, from August 2003 through January 2008, he served as Senior Vice President and General Manager of the Mission Integration Business Unit in SAIC's Intelligence, Security and Technology Group.

As a Senior Vice President with SAIC, he is currently assigned as the Director of Shared Services in SAIC's new Shared Services Center in Oak Ridge, TN.

Before joining SAIC, Mr. Hazlewood had a 23-year career with the Central Intelligence Agency. On detail from CIA, he served as the first Deputy Director of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (then the National Imagery and Mapping Agency). Prior to that position, he served as NGA's first Deputy Director for Operations. In those positions, he was responsible for attempting to unify NGA's capabilities in imagery, imagery intelligence and geospatial information. Before his assignment to NGA, Mr. Hazlewood served in a number of senior assignments at CIA, including Comptroller (now re-named CFO); Director, National Photographic Interpretation Center (NPIC); Executive Director (now re-named Associate Deputy Director); and Deputy Director for Administration (now re-named Director of Support). He retired from CIA in March 2000.

Mr. Hazlewood is a board member of several organizations of national security professionals, including the US Geospatial Intelligence Foundation (USGIF), the Intelligence and National Security Alliance (INSA), and the National Intelligence Education Foundation (NIEF). He received his AB from Georgetown University, an AM from the University of Illinois (Urbana), and a PhD from the University of Pennsylvania.
